






Parts of a castle

1	<p>Castle</p> 	<p>A type of home usually built for Royalty. Castles were designed to keep people safe.</p>
2	<p>Hill</p> 	<p>Lots of castles were built on top of a hill. It was hard for the enemy to get up the hill. People in the castle could see the enemy coming.</p>
3	<p>Moat</p> 	<p>Water that surrounded the castle. This made it hard for people to attack it.</p>
4	<p>Drawbridge</p> 	<p>A bridge over the moat, that led to the entrance. It could be pulled up to stop enemies from getting to the castle.</p>
5	<p>Turret</p> 	<p>Small towers built on top of the wall in a castle. People could see all around from here.</p>
