Wider Curriculum this half-term ...

Understanding of the World -

Science— Light and Shadows.

History— Talk about how traditional tales and rhymes are different to other stories.

Geography—learn about journeys through stories and nursery rhymes.

Class Read

We will be reading lots of books, including non-fiction books about witches. We will think about the witches in Macbeth and compare them to witches from other stories, such as Meg & Mog and Winnie the Witch.

English this half term...

Our main text for this term is Macbeth, by William Shakespeare. We will be reading lots of stories about witches.

Maths this half term ...

We will be learning and understanding how 5 can represent actions as well as physical objects.

Begin to sequence days of the week.
