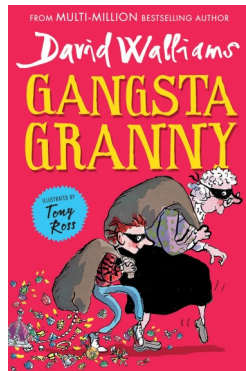
Our Summer 1 unit is *Middlesbrough - Local Landmarks*
